A Message From CEO Linda Broadfoot

Dear Friends,

On behalf of our Board of Directors and the entire Second Helpings team, I'm proud to share with you our 2024-2025 Community Impact Report.

This year, we saw the continued effects of rising food insecurity across Central Indiana, and thanks to your support, we responded with strength, creativity, and compassion.

In our Hunger Relief kitchen, we met that growing need head-on. We prepared and delivered more than 1.3 million meals, responding to increased demand from partners large and small, each one working to feed their neighbors with dignity. By providing meals and rescued food at no cost, we helped our partners save nearly \$18 million. These resources they could then reinvest into their own vital programs and missions.

Meanwhile, our Culinary Job Training program continued to change lives. Each student left our kitchen with the skills, confidence, and support needed to launch a new path forward. These aren't just graduates, they're stories of resilience, hope, and opportunity.

Through our Food Rescue program, we gave a second life to nearly 4.5 millions of pounds of wholesome food that would have otherwise gone to waste. We redirected 2.9 million pounds of what we rescued directly back into the community and into the local food pantry system, stocking shelves so individuals and families has instant access to staple ingredients.

And through it all, you were with us.

Whether you gave, volunteered, shared our story, or simply believed in the power of this mission, you made this work possible. You helped us fight hunger today and plant seeds for a better tomorrow.

From all of us at Second Helpings... thank you.



We receive a variety of donated food from across the culinary industry—grocery stores, caterers, restaurants, and more.




